

## Warm Heads/Warm Hearts Hat

Recommended **Yarns** at Knit One:

Simpliworsted or Zara 8 for worsted = 16-18= 4"

Simplicity, peter pan acrylic or Zara for DK = 22=24"

@ 100-200 yards

### Needles:

Circular needles and/or a set of 4(or 5) double pointed needles in desired gauge

### Notions:

Marker and tapestry needle

<b>Sizing:</b>	@6-18 toddler	@preschool	@school aged
<b>Finished Hat size:</b>	18 ½"	20"	21"

#### 1. Brim

- *Cast on:*

Worsted:	74	80	84
DK:	110	120	128

- *If using double pointed needles, arrange stitches evenly on double pointed needles (3 or 4)*
- Place marker and join in the round, being careful not to twist stitches. Work, in a 1x1 single rib for

1 ½"                      2"                      2 ½"

#### 2. Crown

- Work in stockinette stitch (k on the right side in the round) until the piece measures, from the base of the hat:

6 ½"                      7 ¼"                      8 ¼"

- Work **1 round**, decrease evenly spaced

Worsted:	10	0	4 stitches
DK:	14	8	0

- Leaving

Worsted:	64	80	80 stitches
DK:	96	112	128

### 3. Shape top:

- *Decrease round 1: \*K2, k2tog\** repeat until there remain:

Worsted:	48	60	60 stitches
DK:	72	84	96

- If working in DK, work 1 round even, if working in worsted skip even round and go to decrease round 2
- *Decrease round 2: \*K1, k2tog\** repeat until there remain:

Worsted:	32	40	40stitches
DK:	48	56	64

- If working in DK, work 1 round even, if working worsted skip even round and go to decrease rounds 3, 4 and 5.
- *Decrease rounds 3, 4 and 5: \*K2tog; repeat\** until there remain:

Worsted:	4	5	5 stitches
DK:	6	7	8

### 4. Finishing

- Pull 6 inch tail through the remaining stitches and pull through the center and weave in the wrong side. Block.
- Feel free to add a pom, if appropriate to the age.
